## Guidance for worshippers

On 8 December 2021, the Prime Minister announced the introduction of restrictions aimed at preventing the further spread of coronavirus. As part of these restrictions, **from 10 December, the wearing of facemasks is mandatory in church and we would ask all worshippers and meeting attendees to abide by this regulation unless you are medically exempt from the requirement to wear a mask.**

Facemasks should be worn on entering the building and must remain in place until you have left the building. They can, however, be removed whilst singing.

- The sanitising of hands before entry to and on leaving the church is recommended.
- Windows will remain open to provide adequate ventilation during the services.
- The toilets will be fully opened but users are reminded that they should clean the toilet immediately after use, with the anti-bacterial wipes provided.
- We will continue to refrain from handing out hymn books.
- The use of the pre-filled Communion cups will continue temporarily.
- There will continue to be no creche and no post-service refreshments for the time being.
- The evening service will follow the same pattern and both services will continue to be streamed live on Zoom pending review later.
